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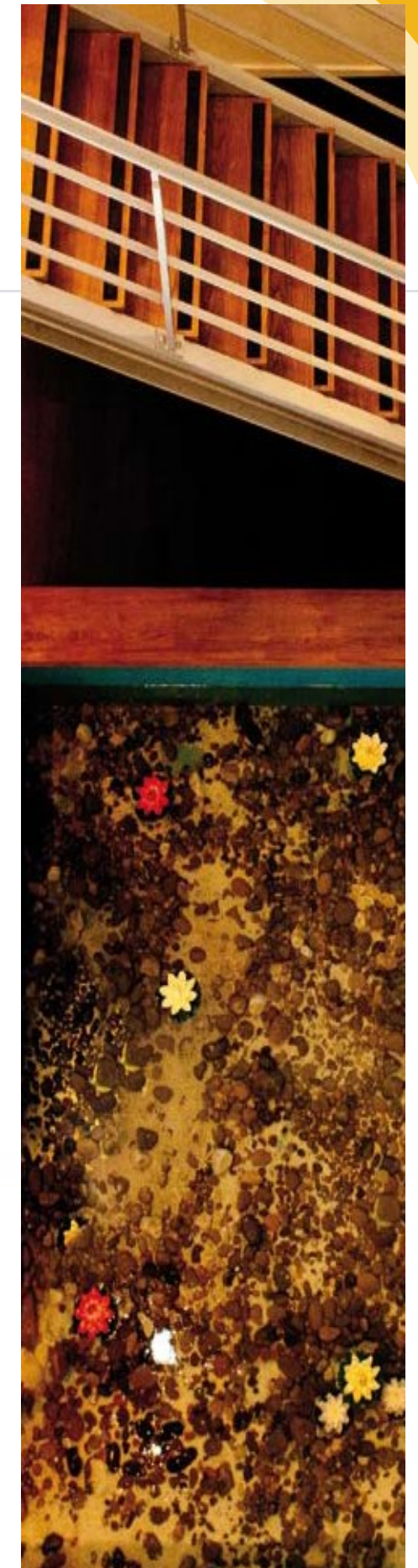
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Introduction

Michael John Academy has delivered successful and high quality vocational training programmes on behalf of Merseyside schools for more than 30 years.

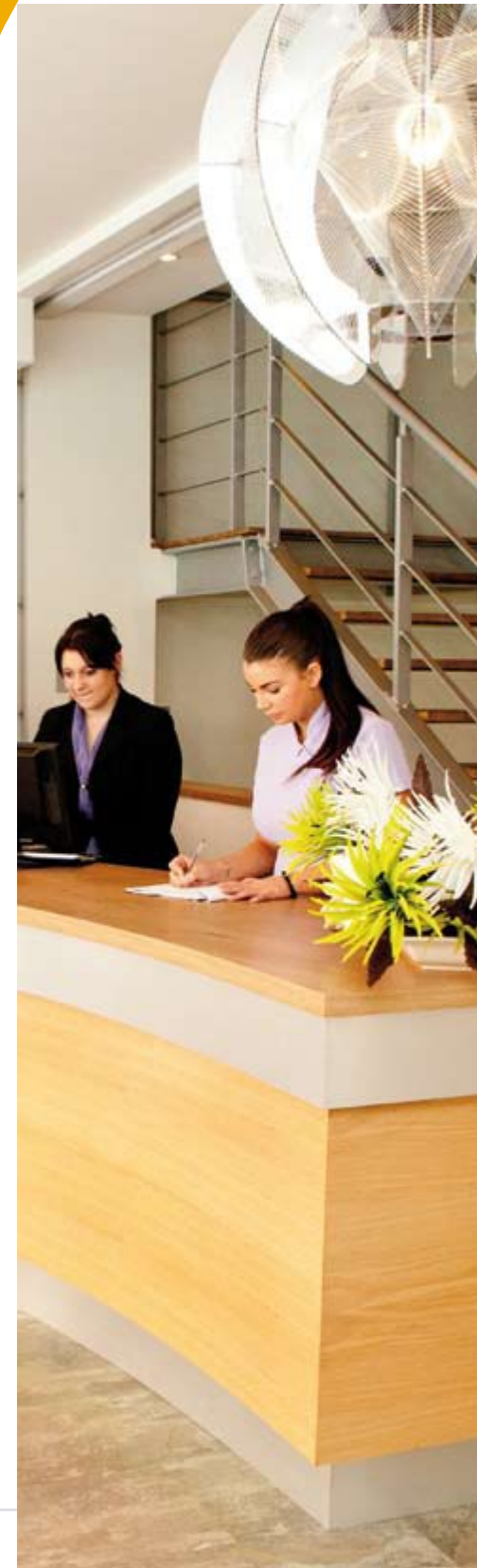

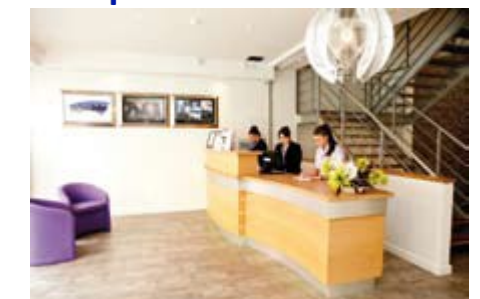

We will keep you informed on student attendance with any unexplained absence notified daily both am and pm.

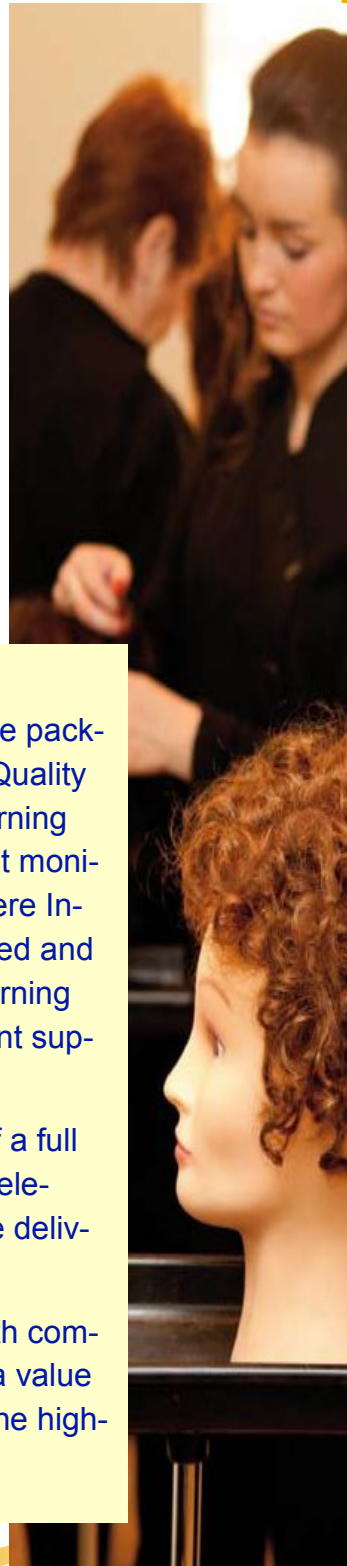
We will provide you with written termly reports on your students progress with Michael John Academy.
