YOU could be entitled to Financial Support

Depending on the training programme you are on.
There are a few types of financial assistance available...

Aged 16 – 19

16-19 Bursary Fund:

FOR LEARNERS ON A MJA FULL TIME COURSE

- You must be 16-18 years old when you started your Study Programme
- The length of your study programme must be over 10 weeks long

A 16-19 BURSARY can help fund selected equipment needs; your salon overall/ tunic; some or all of your travel costs and could provide a small weekly sum.

Generally you will be eligible for this Bursary if you or your parents are receiving any type of benefits.

Aged 19+

Discretionary Learner Support:

FOR LEARNERS AGED 19 OR OVER ON APPRENTICESHIP OR ADULT COURSES

- There are two types of support 19+ Hardship and 20+ Childcare
- To apply for 19+ Hardship you must be 19 years or older when you started your training programme.
- To apply for 20+ Childcare you must be 20 years or older when you started your training programme.

Discretionary learner support can help fund selected equipment needs; your salon overall/ tunic; specific short term travel needs or other types of emergency support.

Aged 19+

19+ Advanced Learning Loan Bursary Fund:

FOR 19 PLUS LEARNERS FUNDING THEIR PROGRAMME VIA A 19 PLUS ADVANCED LEARNING LOAN

- You must be 24plus on a Level 3 or above training programme which is funded via an Advanced Learning Loan.

Learner loan bursary can provide support for learners seen as disadvantaged and can offer assistance with:

- Hardship, Childcare or Residential support
